General Rules Governing Award of Annual Scholarship

- 1. The Alice Hammond Scholarship will be given as an outright grant.
- 2. The Scholarship will be based on financial need as determined by the Alice Hammond Scholarship Committee.
- 3. The selection, of the, recipient shall be made by the Alice Hammond Scholarship Committee.
- 4. The specific procedure regulations are as follows:

A. Candidates

- Must be a resident of Sidney at the time of graduation.
- Preference will be given to students pursuing a teaching degree.
- Must have been accepted for admission to a post secondary institution or vocational institution and must <u>provide a letter</u> from the registrar of that school or institution indicating proof of enrollment.
- Must submit a <u>formal application</u> to be considered by the Alice Hammond Scholarship Committee.
- 5. Payments shall be made by the Treasurer of the Town of Sidney to the college/post secondary school This payment will be applied toward such portion of the student's normal college expenses as may be awarded. In the case where a student fails to enter the institution for the year designated, he/she forfeits the scholarship.
- 6. The reward is open to any student who meets all stated requirements.
- 7. Deadline for applications is April 1st.
