

FEE SCHEDULE
DEMOLITION DEBRIS

TRUCKS

6' Body 7' Body 8' Body One Ton
35.00 40.00 45.00 50.00

TRAILERS

Trailers will be charged \$.55 cents a cubic foot.
Height to 12" =1', over 12"-24" =2', etc.
Length x width x height= number of cubic feet.

The price for trucks includes body sides up to two feet. An additional \$15.00 will be charged for each portion of a foot over two feet. Cross over tool boxes deduct \$10.00.

NO Hazardous Waste in Demo loads. Separate permit required.

BARRELS

Up to a five-gallon bucket \$1.25 each, over 5 gallons up to 30 gallons is \$5.00 each and over 30 gallons up to 55 gallons will be charged \$9.00 each.

BULKY ITEMS

Bulky items will be charged \$7.50 an item (ie: couch, chairs, toys etc).
Mattresses / Box Springs will be charged \$10.00 per item.

TIRES

Passenger tires and light duty truck tires are \$2.00 up to 16" Standard truck tires are \$6.00 each and large skidder/tractor tires are \$20.00. Tires cannot be combined with demolition debris.

ITEMS CONTAINING FREON

Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, or anything containing freon is \$10.00 an item. Items cannot be combined with demolition debris.

WHITE GOODS/METALS

Items such as stoves, washers/dryers or microwaves are free. Doors must be removed. Paint cans must be clean and empty. Remove tires from bicycles.

RECYCLING

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD: Dry corrugated cardboard **MUST** be broken down and all staples removed.

PLASTICS: #2 (milk and soap jugs) & **#5**

OFFICE PAPER: Office paper and junk mail.

TIN CANS: Clean tin cans.

NEWSPAPER/MAGAZINES

CLEAR GLASS (no covers)

OIL/ANTIFREEZE

Separate containers are available for oil and antifreeze. Do not mix other chemicals with them.

HOUSEHOLD TRASH

We have a pay per bag policy. Rubbish bags up to 30-gallon size must have a sticker on it that can be purchased at the Town Office or local stores. Cost of sticker is \$1.50. Stickers can only be used for household rubbish. All other permits must be purchased at the Town Office. They do not have to be used the week that you purchase them.

Stickers and permits are NOT sold at the Transfer Station.

BRUSH, LEAVES, TREES, AND STUMPS

Brush and leaves are not accepted. Use for composting or contact Fire Department for burning permit. Trees and stumps may be brought to Waste Management in Norridgewock; Call them to make arrangements.

Transfer Station hours are Friday, Saturday, and Sunday 8:30AM-4:30PM, unless a holiday.
